Health professionals working with adolescents observe a number of prevalent symptoms for which the answer is essentially cognitive, behavioral and/or pharmaceutical in an attempt to “just fix the situations”. However, rather than seeing these adolescents’ behavior and expressions of pain as pathological “symptoms”, we can also consider them as “symbolic phenomena” in a search for meaning and for finding a place in the World. In this sense, the work of Carl Gustav Jung can inspire us to look differently at contemporary adolescent suffering and to develop widened therapeutic attitudes.
