Complex is one of the most distinctive conceptual components of Analytical Psychology. According to Jung, complexes are the living units of the psyche that lead the royal road to the unconscious. He first demonstrated their existence using the Word Association Test, where the reaction time and quality of response to 'stimulus words' were shown to be individually conditioned by certain categorical principle. How complexes function in the psyche and their interplay between other units became pertinent clinical area to focus on as an analyst. We shall look into the many different kinds of complexes and study their individual and collective implications, supplemented by case presentations.
