## What is a case colloquium?

A colloquium involves active participation by all members in considering material presented by colleagues. It is different from supervision where the primary aim is to advise on the specific case. Here the material is used as a springboard for wider consideration of the principals involved and participants are encouraged to share their experience of similar cases. Participants will take turns to present material.

## Theme: Puer Aeternus

The behaviours associated with this Archetype and the experience of its effects are often referred to as “ the Peter Pan syndrome”. While this is an accurate, if simplified synonym, it belies the complexity of this phenomenon, especially the often severe depression that can come during midlife as a consequence of possession by this Archetype. We might also consider other severe pathologies such as anorexia in the light of this Archetype.

- working diagnosis and preliminary formulation
- Experience of being with the client, any dreams or synchronicities.
- The number of sessions and any themes that you have identified.
